Key information to check

- When are the proposal deadlines? How often do they occur?
- Are you eligible to apply?
- What is the selection process?
- How should proposals be submitted e.g. online or hard copy?

Communication

- Be clear, simple, and specific.
- Nothing will be assumed, if it is not in the application, it is not up for discussion.
- Ensure the questions are answered.
- If you can't say 'what' show in support material.
- CV's are there to speak to your capabilities – let them speak.
- More is more!
